- 1. Teasing;
- 2. Social exclusion;
- 3. Threat;
- 4. Intimidation;
- 5. Stalking;
- 6. Physical violence;
- 7. Theft;
- 8. Sexual, religious, or racial harassment;
- 9. Public or private humiliation; or
- 10. Destruction of property.
